- Old Section VIII became new Section VI
- Added quality costs and management review
- Added material on best practices, benchmarking, and lessons learned
- Added content on language, cultural, and social issues
- Added content on risk management and assessment
- Questions increased 10%

Section VII

- Moved in change control and configuration management
- Moved in verification and validation and risk management tools
- Moved cost of quality to Section VI
- Added 2 pages on common and special causes
- Added cluster sampling and 2 pages on OC curves
- Added material on outliers and software security
- Added lean techniques: pull, VSM, error-proofing
- Questions increased 2%
