

Certified Quality Technician Exam

Objective: To provide recognized quality technician fundamental training and to prepare persons interested in taking the CQT examination.

Certification: Certification is the independently verified prescribed level of knowledge as defined through a combination of experience, education and examination.

The Certified Quality Technician: Is a paraprofessional who, in support of, and under the direction of, quality engineers, can carry out in a responsible manner, proven techniques which make up the body of knowledge recognized by those who are experts in quality technology.

Eligibility: CQT participants must register with ASQ headquarters. Eligibility entails a combination of four years work experience and/or higher education.

Cost: The national test fee is determined by ASQ and is detailed in the CQT brochure.

Location: Exams are given at Prometric Test Centers at dates and times scheduled by the test taker within the given exam dates, and at selected conferences and other locations.

Duration: The Prometric test lasts 4.5 hours and contains 110 questions. A written test (at selected sites) contains 100 questions.
