Certified Quality Technician Exam

- <u>Objective:</u> To provide recognized quality technician fundamental training and to prepare persons interested in taking the CQT examination.
- <u>Certification:</u> Certification is the independently verified prescribed level of knowledge as defined through a combination of experience, education and examination.
- <u>The Certified Quality Technician:</u> Is a paraprofessional who, in support of, and under the direction of, quality engineers, can carry out in a responsible manner, proven techniques which make up the body of knowledge recognized by those who are experts in quality technology.
- <u>Eligibility:</u> CQT participants must register with ASQ headquarters. Eligibility entails a combination of four years work experience and/or higher education.
- <u>Cost:</u> The national test fee is determined by ASQ and is detailed in the CQT brochure.
- <u>Location:</u> Exams are given at Prometric Test Centers at dates and times scheduled by the test taker within the given exam dates, and at selected conferences and other locations.
- <u>Duration:</u> The Prometric test lasts 4.5 hours and contains 110 questions. A written test (at selected sites) contains 100 questions.
